



## Teaching Community Committee Terms of Reference

### **PURPOSE**

### **MEMBERSHIP**

1. The Chairperson will be on rotation. The committee will select a member to report back to the SRSAN network.
2. The committee will include but not limited to members of SRSAN and shall have a minimum of six to a maximum of eight members. The committee has the authority to invite other committee members.

## **RESOURCES**

Any expenses/costs needed to assist in fulfilling the committee's objectives shall be brought forward to the SRSAN membership for approval.

Three absences/regrets shall mean removal from the committee to the discretion of the committee.

The committee will continue to be a standing committee of the South Region Self-Advocacy Network until the Annual Retreat in June 2012.
